Computer & TV Recycling Drop-Off Opens May 1st
For Hamilton County Residents

The Hamilton County Solid Waste Management District (District) will be collecting obsolete computer equipment and televisions from Hamilton County residents beginning May 1st through December 30th, at 2trg located at 11093 Kenwood Road, Building #7, Blue Ash, OH 45242.

Hamilton County residents interested in participating in this program can drop-off their unwanted computer equipment/TVs Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The site will be open on the following Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.: June 13th, August 8th and October 10th. The site will be closed on major holidays including Memorial Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Residents must bring proof of residency, such as a driver's license or utility bill, in order to participate. This program prohibits the acceptance of computer equipment/TVs from businesses, churches, schools and non-profit organizations.

Items accepted at no charge: monitors, CPUs, hard drives, mice, keyboards, lap tops, docking stations, back-up batteries, power cords, speakers, modems, external hard drives, memory chips, storage chips, cellular phones, printers, scanners, and desk top fax machines.
