FREE to Hamilton County Residents Only.

Bring proof of residency, such as a driver's license or utility bill.

Landscapers and commercial establishments are not eligible to participate in this program!

Yardwaste Recycling Drop-Off Site Rules:

- Landscapers and commercial establishments are not eligible to participate in this program!
- No large trailers or trucks larger than pickups.
- Cut brush and tree branches into lengths of 4 feet or less—branches must not exceed 1 foot in diameter.
- Bundle brush and tree branches—bundles must not be heavier than 75 pounds.
- Bring yardwaste to the locations in containers or bags—brown paper bags preferred.
- Containers and plastic bags will be returned.
- No pallets, boards, nails, fence, or wire accepted.
- No bricks, stones, or soil accepted.
- Hamilton County residents only.
- All children must stay inside vehicles.
