

**Hamilton County Sheriff Inmate Work Detail program  
Education Programs - July 17, 2008 - July 31, 2009**

As part of the litter collection program, the District contracted with Keep Cincinnati Beautiful to conduct litter prevention programs in an amount not to exceed \$9,000. From July 17, 2008 through July 31, 2009, KCB conducted 18 litter education programs to elementary students and civic groups, reaching 2,006 people. In addition, two communities participated in the Great American Clean-Up (GAC) for the first time. KCB staff also talked with the participating communities about the results of the programs and encouraged them to participate in the Adopt-a-Spot program as a means of sustaining litter collection in their community.
