

**2006 - 2007 School Waste Minimization Grant

PROJECT SUMMARY: Wyoming High School would like to begin a co-mingled recycling program using Rumpke as their recycling hauler. Each classroom will have a paper collection box, and can and bottle collection containers will be set-up around the school. The HOPE Environmental club will empty collection containers, and promote recycling within the school and community. Grant money is requested to pay for Rumpke's monthly service fee and pay for some advertising and promotion of the program. Total amount requested is \$860.00.

PROJECT SUMMARY: The School for Creative and Performing Arts began a recycling program 3 years ago which includes commingled recycling through Rumpke and ink cartridge recycling. The school would like to make improvements to the program. Grant funds are being requested to purchase equipment

such as carts with wheels, containers, can crushers as well as some consumable supplies such as rubber gloves and can liners. Funds are also being requested to purchase acrylic paint to decorate some of the existing recycling containers, and for advertising of the program through a newsletter to the schools' 700 families. Total amount being requested is \$1,000.00.
