Potential Grant Opportunities

Potential Funding for Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program

Lowe's Charitable Foundation

Minimum Amount: \$5,000

Maximum amount: \$25,000

Summary

The purpose of this program is to support the communities through funding provided to public education, community improvement projects, and home safety initiatives.

Duke Energy Foundation

Maximum amount: Dependent upon request

Summary

Support programs that support conservation, training, and research around environmental and energy efficiency initiatives.

CARE Program - USEPA

Minimum Amount: \$90,000

Maximum amount: \$275,000

Summary

The purpose of this program is to assist communities with understanding, reducing, and responding to risks posed by toxins and other environmental pollutants from all sources.

USEPA Great Lakes National Program Office

Maximum Amount: \$50,000

Summary

GLNPO requests proposals for pollution prevention, reduction, or elimination, with an emphasis on substances which are persistent and toxic, especially those which bioaccumulate, in the Great Lakes basin.

Potential Funding for General Recycling Awareness

US Dept. of Agriculture, Rural Development - Solid Waste Management Grants

Maximum amount: Based on the amount of match provided.

Summary

Rural Development can grant funds to identify and evaluate solutions to solid waste problems on a regional basis in rural areas relating to collection, treatment, disposal, and recycling.

Resource Conservation Challenge - USEPA

Maximum amount: \$200,000

Summary

The purpose of this program is to support projects that address solid waste reduction, recycling, and waste management issues. Assistance is available for unique, innovative, and replicable projects that will have quantifiable positive environmental impacts and address regionally significant environmental issues.

Potential Funding for Pollution Prevention Internship Program

Source Reduction Assistance Grant - USEPA

Maximum amount: \$163,000

Summary

The source reduction assistance (SRA) grants program provides grants and cooperative agreements to fund pollution prevention activities. EPA is interested in funding projects which assist in reducing hazardous substances, pollutants, or contaminants entering waste streams.

Potential Funding for Computer/Television Events

ODNR Community Development Grants

Minimum Amount: \$10,000

Maximum amount: \$150,000

Summary

The Division of Recycling & Litter Prevention provides funding in the form of Community Development Grants. Grant funds are available to implement litter collection events on public property and provide funding for the operation of: illegal dumpsite cleanup efforts, roadway litter collection projects, special or event-oriented projects, and targeted waste projects.

Potential Funding for Multiple Programs

Ohio Environmental Action Fund – Ohio EPA

Maximum amount: \$50,000

Potential funding for: Pollution Prevention Program, school recycling, general awareness programs.

Summary

The purpose of this program is to enhance Ohio citizens' awareness and understanding of environmental issues by supporting environmental education and outreach programs. Assistance is available for environmental education projects targeting the general public, preschool through university students and teachers, and the regulated community.
