The Cincinnati Health Department's (CHD) 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Report 2008 covering the months October through December was received on January 22, 2009.

The CHD identified the following open dump activities:

The transfer station on Este Ave. received its operating license from the CHD on August 27, 2004. Although the transfer station is not yet receiving solid waste, inspections were conducted in October, November and December 2008. No violations were reported.
